

*Message from Rudy Trembl,

These AVP's are all excellent CRA leaders with many years of experience in CRA organizational matters.

To make this an easy transition, I would like all SASA Chapters to close-out all SASA related business before March 1, 2012 which means submitting to the CRA Association Treasurer, Pat Branson, any outstanding CRA -150 reimbursement requests for local printing/mailing of ENCORE and any outstanding CRA-124 reimbursement requests for Membership Solicitation costs which need to be submitted to me for approval. Thereafter, all future Chapter and SG activities will fall under the guidance of the above three AVP's.

My last scheduled SASA activities will be visits to the SF Chapter in Miami on February 4th and the Jacksonville Chapter on February 28th.
