Tour Times: Our group tour will start around 10:00am and last approximately 1 hour, including our special heritage food presentation and tasting. After our tour, we encourage you to revisit the various Living History exhibits for more indepth discussion with the volunteers and participants.

Parking: Free parking available on the street during weekends. Nearby lots: [Church and Council Lot](#) - \$5 on weekends.

What to expect: An amazing guided tour of the Presidio and the Presidio's Living History program, which brings life inside the walls of the Presidio

- An explanation of the history of the Presidio
- A tour of the changing exhibits in the Jacome-Siquieros home that also houses the Museum Shop
- A glimpse into a Presidio-era home and barracks
- An opportunity to see an exact replica of an 18th century cannon
- An explanation of a 2,000 year old Native American pit house and what it represented
- A view of a store-room used for food and supplies
- An opportunity to learn from Presidio docents stationed around the Presidio Courtyard. These stations could display cotton and wool carding, spinning, and the soldier's equipment and how it was used.

Depending on availability, we are hoping renowned Tucson historian, archaeologist and Presidio Board President Homer Thiel will join us for his personal in-depth view of Tucson prehistory through colonial times. For Homer's bio, please visit:
